Founded in 2004, GT Independence was created out of the basic instinct of a parent trying to provide the very best options for their child.











Our Origins: Cash & Counseling

Background:

- Rigorous, randomized controlled trial of selfdirection as compared to traditional agency services
- 3 states: Arkansas, Florida, and New Jersey.
 Later replication studies in 12 additional states.
- Nearly 7,000 participants

Key Findings:

- The program had overwhelming positive effects on consumers of all ages, and their caregivers.
- Consumers who managed their own care were far happier with their care and their lives in general, and experienced no more—and in some cases significantly fewer—adverse events than those receiving agency care















Overview of Self-Direction and Strategic Relevance



Empowering Individual Autonomy

Self-direction allows individuals to choose who provides their care, when, and how, promoting autonomy and personal choice.

Alignment with Value-Based Care

Self-direction improves member satisfaction, compliance, and health outcomes, aligning with value-based care goals of MCOs.

Operational Efficiencies for MCOs

This model reduces administrative burdens and enhances caregiver retention, increasing operational efficiencies for Managed Care Organizations.

Regulatory Support and Strategic Opportunity

CMS supports self-direction through person-centered planning, giving MCOs a strategic opportunity to meet regulations and improve care quality.





Improved Compliance and Satisfaction



Higher Satisfaction Levels

Members report greater satisfaction by tailoring care delivery to their preferences and needs through self-direction.

Improved Health Outcomes

Self-direction reduces unmet care needs, lowers emergency visits, and contributes to better overall health outcomes.

Benefits for Managed Care Organizations

Improved compliance leads to predictable care, reduced risks, and enhanced performance in value-based care models.

Enhanced Member Autonomy

Self-direction allows members to choose trusted caregivers and schedule services fitting their routines, boosting engagement.

Caregiver Retention and Shift Reliability

Caregiver Retention Rate	65%	85%
Missed Shift Rate	30%	10%
Continuity of Care	Moderate	High
Administrative Burden	High	Low



Cost Savings: Agency vs. Self-Directed Care Models

Aspect	Agency-Based Model	Self-Directed Model
Average Hourly Cost	\$21–\$40/hour (varies by state and service type) [h2hhc.com]	\$14–\$28/hour (often 20–30% lower than agency rates) [agingtoday.com]
Administrative Overhead	High – includes agency fees, supervision, compliance costs	Low – participants manage care directly, reducing overhead [macpac.gov]
Budget Control	Limited – agency controls spending	Full – participants allocate funds, set wages, and negotiate rates [medicaid.gov]
Estimated Cost Savings	_	10–30% savings over agency-based models, depending on state and program design [pb.appliedection.com]






GT App




GT Portal


